

Student Registration Process

1 Currently enrolled as a student in a CMBC recognized midwifery education program

2 Submit application for student registration to CMBC (Fee: \$75)

- Applicant creates an online account at: <https://public.cmbc.bc.ca/account>

3 Receive information from CMBC Registration Coordinator

- Registration Coordinator sends applicant information and assesses application for outstanding items.

4 Submit all required documents

- Documents include (but are not limited to) proof of enrollment in a CMBC recognized midwifery education program and proof of authorization to reside and study in Canada.
- Request for and consent to criminal record check.
